“MEMBERS OF THE US LIFESAVING SERVICE, US LIGHTHOUSE SERVICE, US LIGHTSHIP SERVICE AND MASSACHUSETTS HUMANE SOCIETY WERE ALL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES AND THE ORGANIZATIONS EVENTUALLY ROLLED UP INTO THE FORMATION OF THE US COAST GUARD IN 1915. THEREFORE, IT IS APPROPRIATE TO PLACE AMERICAN FLAGS ON THEIR GRAVES.” (US Lifesaving Service Historical Association)
